

WATERCOLOR SUPPLY LIST

Students must purchase their own supplies

WATERCOLOR: AN HISTORICAL APPROACH - PART 1

Watercolor: An Historical Approach follows the journey of watercolor as it moves from a preparatory or documentary painting medium to a medium accepted by the art world for its unique expressive properties. The class covers contour drawing, a botanical study, and landscapes, including the change in landscape painting from topographical representations to expressions the artist's emotional response to a landscape rendered in watercolor. Students may copy artist's paintings or create original paintings applying concepts presented in class. This Tuesday morning class begins on September 12 and ends on October 31. The class is from 9:00 AM to 12:00 noon at the Green Tree Fire Station's Carlisle Social Hall. Please bring your painting supplies to the first class. If you plan to create original paintings, bring reference photos and/or drawings.

PAPER

140-lbs. (weight) Cold-press rag paper. 2 full sheets (22 inches x30 inches may be purchased from the instructor) Arches is a readily available popular brand. Paper may be purchased in blocks or as individual sheets. If using individual sheets you need a support (board) and masking tape.

PAINT

A list of the seven primary colors used for the class is available from the instructor at terigeever@yahoo.com.

Please buy professional quality paint. Look for Artists' Water Color when purchasing paint. Some professional quality brands include Da Vinci, Holbein, Schmincke, Winsor & Newton, Sennelier, Maimeri and American Journey. Feel free to add colors. You may want to include white, black, green, orange, indigo, turquoise, etc.

BRUSHES

Natural hair brushes (sable) are best for applying paint to the paper. You may buy synthetic brushes to save money. Round # 5, # 8 and # 12
Flat 1/2 and 1 inch.

Synthetic hair brushes are good for lifting paint from the paper. Flat 1/2 inch.

ODDS & ENDS

Support for paper (if individual sheets), masking tape, pencils, eraser, palette, water container. Additional supplies you may want to have available include paper towels, tissues, sponges, drawing and tracing paper, and reference photos or drawings.
