Sky and Water is designed to teach a variety of watercolor painting techniques for representations of skies and water. In the first sessions, students will paint clear, cloudy, and stormy skies following step-by-step instructions. Students will paint still, flowing, and turbulent waters following step-by-step instructions in later sessions. Students will be encouraged to apply these watercolor painting techniques to original paintings from their own visual references.

Please bring your painting supplies and reference drawings and/or photos of landscapes that include streams, rivers, waterfalls, lakes and/or storms to the first class.

**SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR CLASS**

**PAPER**

**FOR WATERCOLOR PAINTING:**

140-lbs. (weight) Cold-press rag paper. 2 full sheets (22 inches x30 inches may be purchased from the instructor) Arches is a readily available popular brand. Paper may be purchased in blocks or as individual sheets. If using individual sheets, you need a support (board) and masking tape.

**FOR DRAWING:**

Good quality drawing paper 11x15 inches or larger, tracing paper, drawing pencils, eraser, and drawing board.

**PAINT**

Please buy professional quality paint. Look for Artists' Water Color when purchasing paint. Some professional quality brands include Da Vinci, Holbein, Schmincke, Winsor & Newton, Sennelier, Maimeri and American Journey. Feel free to add colors. You may want to include white, black, green, orange, indigo, turquoise, etc.

**BRUSHES**

Natural hair brushes (sable) are best for applying paint to the paper. You may buy synthetic brushes to save money.

Round # 5, # 8 and # 12

Flat ½ and 1 inch.

Synthetic hair brushes are good for lifting paint from the paper. Flat ½ inch.

**ODDS & ENDS**

Support for paper (if individual sheets), masking tape, pencils, eraser, palette, water container. Additional supplies you may want to have available include paper towels, tissues, sponges, drawing and tracing paper, and reference photos or drawings
